

## **President's Speech: Opening of the 7th Parliament of WolvHaven**

Welcome senators and members of the house of representatives to the state opening of the 7th parliament of WolvHaven. On the 2nd of July, 2017 the polls closed for the second General Election in WolvHaven's history. The turnout for this election was higher than ever seen in any WolvHaven election that has come before it. This represents the overwhelming shift towards democracy that has been seen across WolvHaven over the past months. As WolvHaven grows and prospers, its democratic institutions are developing too; there are more elected seats in the House of Representatives, so that the public is represented in a much better way, and the progress of a bill through Parliament is more transparent than ever before. My government will continue this trend and help the free and democratic establishments we cherish here in WolvHaven grow and prosper for the good of our Nation.

### **Gardellia.**

My government will be committed throughout its 3 month term to deliver a series of policy changes to help make Gardellia more welcoming and resilient for the times ahead. These of course include the establishment of a new Gardellia Council which has been long overdue and acutely needed since Gardellia opened over 6 months ago. The plan to establish this council has been reviewed and refined over the past weeks in preparation to implement it. The Gardellia Federalisation & Council Establishment Bill will aid Gardellia to thrive and develop in a much more arranged and secure manner. Many issues have arisen recently in Gardellia regarding land infringement, disputes, and infrastructure that have not been dealt with properly. This bill seeks to deal with these issues in a more constructive and effective way as to move away from these issues and look to the future. My government also has planned to introduce other policies which will be brought in promptly such as the establishment of Green Belts around cities in Gardellia which may be expanding to a point where they are hampering the development of other towns and cities. The Green Belts will be introduced on a case by case basis, as to not impose the Green Belts unfairly and so that the City mayors can therefore have a handle on the decisions made. My government sees this policy helping to keep Gardellia clean and welcoming for the future generations of WolvHaveners to come. To supplement this the government shall also propose harder policy on the towns that are left abandoned for long periods of time on Gardellia. These deserted settlements take up unnecessary space on the Gardellia world and prevent skilled and consistent builders from claiming stations. This policy should make it so that a decision is made about the town 3 months after it has been abandoned. The owner will have a chance to overturn a decision meaning that towns will not be immediately demolished at the owner's expense. This policy will give opportunities for more development on Gardellia and prevent land being wasted where it could be put to much better use. Overall, my government has strong policy on Gardellia and will rectify the cracks that currently exist in the system which are impeding Gardellia's healthy development. With this new government, we shall also see a new Gardellia.

**Civil Rights.**

This government will work for the rights of our most vulnerable citizens who have been neglected and left behind by previous administrations. The government believes that marriage is for all citizens of Wolvhaven and that the rights of such citizens should be met. So the coalition has already proposed a bill that will make LGBTQ+ marriages legal under Wolvhaven law and extend civil rights and liberties to everyone. To develop the Civil Rights package, my government will provide Citizens with more freedoms and opportunities with the introduction of Citizen TPA. Citizens have been neglected for too long on regards to this issue, and have been prevented from roaming the world as they should have been. This government pledges to change the current situation and provide Citizens with the rights and powers that they deserve to have.

**Copyright.**

My government will also ensure that a server copyright rule is implemented. The government believes that copying parts of another building on the server, or taking parts of the structure from another person's creation on the server, is wrong. It also hinders development of entirely new and forward-thinking ideas which would bring a better outlook for wolvhaven overall. People shall only be granted permission for this if they have asked the person they will be copying from, and if they have been given permission. This will most likely result in more diversity and variation across wolvhaven and will encourage the advancement of new ideas and designs for buildings. What makes wolvhaven unique is our wide variety of styles and characteristics for buildings across the city, and this policy will help to keep that trend and preserve our uniqueness.

## **The Economy.**

Currently in WolvHaven, our Economic model is grossly imbalanced and disproportionate to the current state of affairs, this is a situation that only continues to worsen and a situation that my government pledges to resolve.

An Economic Revamp was already being considered before this election, but was not put in place, therefore this government is as committed as ever to realising and attaining a successful revamp which will benefit all different people that reside in wolvhaven. This economic revamp will allow people to reinvent themselves and achieve more in WolvHaven. The government also strongly believes that Architects that put tremendous amounts of effort into developing WolvHaven city should be rewarded for their contributions and rightly so. The current economic model sees that the only voluntary way to make money on the server is to work on survival performing certain jobs. This creates a situation where architects who do not have much interest or ambition to play on the survival world are neglected from earning any money and therefore are unreasonably treated despite their achievements on the city world.
