Written 17 September 2017

Inquiry into the following of proper parliamentary procedure by clerks & the speaker of the house

Summary of findings

- Involved individuals: Ninjabob1797 (speaker), Hinwapoon (clerk), Autobus22(leader of the opposition)
- Retracting of calls too early
 - Speaker was reasonable in retracting _Noodur's call due to silence after _Noodur asked a question.
 - Speaker was reasonable in retracting the leader of the opposition's call as the time allocated for the bill had run out.
 - Speaker retracted call too early as he lost track of time
- Votes not counted properly
 - Leader of the opposition was not queueing up or at the entrance of the voting lobby the moment the division ended and vote was not counted.
 - Ardyle's vote not counted was due to error partly due to lack of communication. Clerk also gave the wrong reasoning for the vote not being counted and vote was fixed in the hansard.
- Elapsed times of bills
 - Speaker was found to have given reasonable amount of time for all bills except the Drivers' Union Bill which was put to vote 1 minute 30 seconds earlier than it should have.
- Removal of leader of the opposition from the chamber
 - Leader of the opposition argued with speaker and clerk over whether Ardyle's vote should or should not be counted.
 - Speaker and Clerk were frustrated given the leader of the opposition's behaviour throughout the session.
 - Members of SGNP JuliusMS and Olovld were not helping by jeering against the leader of the opposition in an aggressive fashion.
- "Incorrect" order of call by speaker
 - Speaker not required to follow any order where calls are given.



- Unparliamentary behaviour
 - Leader of the opposition
 - Interrupted several other members' calls for a point of order and failed to raise the point of order correctly.
 - Interrupted vote of the voices with his own opinion
 - Backseat moderated in the chamber
 - JuliusMS & Olovld
 - Made very aggressive remarks towards the leader of the opposition and will be asked to withdraw those remarks at the next session.

Findings

A: Retracting calls too early

Observations:

As seen in the speakers' chatlogs, the call was given to _Noodur. However there was much dead silence after _Noodur asked his question. This is also reflected in the hansard for 16 September 2017 that was written by the parliamentary clerk Hinwapoon during the session itself. The speaker may have assumed that _Noodur has went AFK after his question or had forgotten to use fin to indicate the end of his call.

When the speaker asked the honourable member to resume his seat, the honourable member had the chance to say that he was still typing, as with past instances. Had he done this, the call would have automatically be given back to the member. However, no point of order was raised and further calls were allocated to ezzo and the leader of the opposition accordingly without any form of attempt to get the call again from _Noodur.

The speaker has also noted that there was only 10 minutes remaining for the bill. It is therefore fair to assume that it was the end of the call and the remaining time was to be put to better use to other honourable members who wished to speak on the issue.

The leader of the opposition's call in the 5th Haven Green-Spaces Bill

Allegation by the leader of the opposition:

Observations:

While the call was cut short of the 5 minutes maximum speaking time per call, a subsequent point of order was called by the leader of the opposition. However, this point of order was about the order of the call being given to the prime minister instead of the member Noodur.

While the call was indeed cut 1 minute 10 seconds before the allocated time would have elapsed, it is worth noting that a point of order should have been raised over the duration of the call. Otherwise, the speaker would not have known.

While it is stated on the order paper that speeches are capped at 5 minutes, the speaker has the discretion to cut the time allocated with reasoning.

Speaker's reasoning:

He was trying to make up for lost time as the session had severe time constraints and there was not much time left for the bill to be debated upon as parliament was running slightly late.

Therefore, the speaker cut short the calls in the interest of time and ensuring that more voices could be heard in the debate.



This is not the first time a speaker has cut short the amount of time. In the first session of the parliamentary term, after the July General Elections, speaker SilverWolv cut short some calls as time was tight due to the number of bills tabled.

In the second case, the bill was put to voting directly after the call was cut. Hence, the cutting of the call was appropriate because the allocated time of 30 minutes of the bill was expiring. We cannot expect the speaker to always be a hundred percent accurate with timing to the minute. Therefore, the cutting of the call was appropriate.

Actions taken:

The speaker has been notified about the first instance and will try not to cut calls short of the 5 minutes cap in the future unless necessary.

B: Votes were not counted properly

**Recount by Speaker:**

- The leader of the opposition was not responding in the main chamber and only started moving towards the ayes lobby when he announced for the doors to be locked.
- However; as the lobby was not visible from the speaker's' chair, he was unable to confirm if the leader of the opposition made it or not

Recount by Hinwapoon (clerk):

- When the speaker announced lock the doors, the leader of the opposition was not in front of the desk to count the votes
- Eventually, the leader of the opposition flew to the entrance

Observations:

It is near impossible to determine whether the leader of the opposition's vote is to be considered. However, both the clerk and the speaker noted that the leader of the opposition only started moving towards the ayes lobby in the closing seconds of division. There is also no way to track players' movement in the server. Block logs involve the placing, removal or interaction with blocks.

The other members were in the voting lobbies and therefore could not see if the leader of the opposition was indeed in front of the entrance when the speaker announced for the doors to be locked.

SilverWolv told the leader of the opposition on Saturday 15 59 UTC +-0 that as long as one is in the chamber, they should still be allowed to vote. However, this is incorrect. Votes are only to be counted if the person is in front of the desk to enter the lobby or in the queue to enter the lobby.

The division ends the moment "lock the doors" is announced - regardless of whether the doors are physically shut or not. If members are not within the queue when this is announced, the clerk should not count the vote.



Drivers Union Bill

Allegation by the leader of the opposition:

17.43.13 Ardy teleported in line to vote 3 minutes up front closure (<https://i.imgur.com/qAmdSFj.png>). Vote did not get counted, raised point of order 3 times, did not get recognised. and he was blamed for being late.

Observations:

The announcement to lock the doors was given. However, there was no clerk present to man the aye chamber due to a lack of manpower. The reason hinwapoon did not log the vote was due to a misunderstanding that once lock the doors is announced, no further votes are to be logged. Regardless of whether you were already in the queue or not. However, it is worth noting that the member Ardyle should have also asked that the clerk count his vote.

Due to the issue of manpower, and the requesting of vote to be counted when the division ended, the clerk would also be unable to verify if Ardyle was already queueing before the division ended.



Actions Taken:

The clerk has been advised to check both lobbies regularly in the event of a lack of manpower. As this situation is not very common, there was no confirmed procedure in place for this type of situation. Ardyle's vote has been accepted and is now reflected in the hansard.



C: Elapsed times of bills

Allegations by the leader of the opposition:

1. 16.32.41 Retracted topic over 10 minutes early making it impossible for the bill proposal (me) to respond back to criticism

2. 17.10.13 call got cut off 3 minutes too early leaving me (autobus22) unable to respond fully to previous arguments again. (Total time for topic time also wasn't reached at 29 minutes)

3. 17.39.37 Call got cut off 4 minutes too early leaving me again unable to respond to anything and to try to clarify what the bill does. (This bill was only 18 minutes in, the bill was cut off 12 minutes too early as well)

Observations: Citizen Test Screenshot Regulation Bill

Although on the order paper it states 30 minutes, the time allocated is inclusive of the 5 minutes of division time for the second reading. The time elapsed for bills begins when the bill is introduced to the house. Therefore, there is only 25 minutes for debate, meaning this bill is still well within reasoning to be called for voting. Furthermore, it is highly unlikely that another call can be made within the time limit.

The time between which the bill was introduced to the house and the moment the division ended was just under 31 minutes. Therefore, the bill was well within the allocated amount of time.

Observations: 5th Haven Green Spaces Bill

Although the order paper allocates 30 minutes, the 30 minutes is inclusive of the 5 minutes of division time for the second reading. The time elapsed for bills starts when the bill is introduced to the house. Therefore, there is only 25 minutes for debate. Therefore, this bill has overrun its allocated time by 4 minutes 22 seconds.

**Observations: Drivers' Union Bill**

The speaker had lost track of time and has indeed incorrectly terminated the debate for the bill 2 minutes too early. Considering the additional 5 minutes required for the division.

Actions taken:

The speaker has been advised of this issue and will be keeping more accurate track of time in the future using a device.

According to parliamentary procedure, the speaker does not have to honor the queueing of the members as he may give the call to any member at his or her discretion. This is evident in past parliamentary sessions from 2015 and 2016 wherein acting speaker SilverWolv did not call members in the order of queue to speak and allowed for the incorrect calls to proceed.

The powers of the speaker also allow him or her to determine the maximum amount of time allowed for any speeches.



F: Unparliamentary Behaviour

The leader of the opposition

There have been several cases of the leader of the opposition displaying unparliamentary behaviour within the chamber

Interrupting calls to call for a point of order

The way the leader of the opposition called for a point of order was incorrect. According to the parliamentary guidelines, if one is a frontbencher, they should proceed to the dispatch box and wait for the speaker to give the call for a point of order, not interject someone else's call as shown in the speaker's chatlogs below.

This is the same for the rest of the point of orders raised by the leader of the opposition.
