Permanent Residency Bill

Tabled By:

Debate:

1. [minebuilder1223, PM, MP, PFG] Thank you Mr. Speaker. The government fully supports this bill and we believe that it will further strengthen peacekeeping in Wolvhaven and help to filter out troublemakers.
2. [autobus22, MP, HGP] Well I'd like to suggest to put the bill on hold, I principally support the bill, but I'd like to see what the current general law changes (WolvHaven Statutes) do in this case.
3. [Rom5419, MP, NAT] Thank you mr speaker, this is in response to the previous MP's suggestion to temporarily suspend the bill. Firstly, the wolvhaven law statute has already considered changes to be introduced by this bill. The laws are already planned to be amended to accommodate the contents of this bill is passed. Secondly, there is a reason why since this bill has a lot of potential impact on the server, all changes to ranks will be gradual and incremental. Not all at once, it requires approval from all sides. Lastly, there are no changes to the tourist rank in this bill. Only to what happens after a tourist decides to take the citizen test. Not changes to tourist rank in the statutes either. So this bill will help to fill in the missing link.
4. [SilverWolv, Independent] Thank you Mr. Speaker. May i refer the House to the part of the bill that documents promotion criteria to citizen. It states that one should provide an introductory document providing several information including "stating their identity details". Can the member define such details? Also our existing citizenship clearance system is already very troublesome and complex for new players. Where we have to do a Background Check (BGC) on passees. They also have to get on the discord just to submit a screenshot and wait for BGC processing. Can the member opposite assure that this won't discourage potential new players by making an existing immigration system more complex?

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5. [ROM5419, MP, NAT] Thank you Mr. Speaker. Firstly the identity details part, this does not refer to real life personal details like IRL name, address, and such. Rather, just a brief declaration of one's online presence, such as IGN, forum name, discord tag, and usernames of alts (if applicable), etc. Along with other contents that the citizen applicant might feel appropriate to share with staff. An example can be synthesised from the recent demographic census. Secondly, yes, this MP recognized that the current immigration system is already quite complex. However, there are still some instances where citizen applicants of malicious intent abuse the system. Also, there are some people who take their citizenship for granted. Coming here, applying for full citizenship, then leaving, and not come back for a long time. Or, just happen to use only the city world and barely touch on the other facilities for citizens. At least the PR status can not only allow the citizen test to be safely automated again, but also provide a buffer rank for people who want more than what tourist rank has to offer, yet have not made the decision to stay permanently.
6. [MC_Dunc, MP, DEM] This MP and the opposition supports the bill and would like add a remark no system is perfect, this is close to perfection we can achieve right now
7. [autobus22, MP, HGP] Okay let's keep this simple - Claim to re-automate citizen test? Yes it does, but then it moves work forward a step meaning in the end just as much work is needed. By that there is no evidence to support this bill should currently pass, because the basis of the bill isn't proven to exist currently. The new punishment system in the law already eliminated the need for such a buffer either way as they provide a buffer in a slightly different method already by when and how punishments can be applied. Right now the simple conclusion is that this bill should either be denied or put on hold till we know whether such possibly destructive action towards new members is still needed.
8. [y0urs_TrU1y, Independent] I would like to point out that the "new punishment system that my dear autobus alluding to earlier is not at all new. All I did, is tell him that it exists
9. [ROM149, MP, NAT] Firstly the claim to "re-automate citizen test". Actually, the new citizen test will only promote to PR level, which should have enough terror safeguards already. So an immigration test. Also, re-automating is not part of this bill, it only gives an opportunity to do so in the future. Secondly, yes, this MP agrees that this bill, even if passed by the lower house may be put on hold before senate vote. In order to allow for a controlled experiment with the old system before deciding if this bill is worth it. Finally, since there are still lots of questions to be resolved, this MP moves to adjourn debate on this bill to another session. This MP predicts that at least four readings may be required as this is quite a lengthy bill with lots of controversy.

Permanent Residency Bill 2017/2018

Commence the introduction, implementation, and optimisation of the Permanent Residency rank as an interim rank between sojourn and citizenship as part of immigration reform.

Be it enacted by the president of the federation of WolvHaven, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and Representatives, in this parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as follows -

1. New Permanent Resident (PR) rank for new immigrants (players)

- a. New players who have passed both the Citizen Test and manual background checks will be promoted to PR rather than be granted citizenship.
- b. The primary purpose of the PR rank is to provide an additional layer of security to protect against new players of malicious intent, and maintain the culture and demographics of the server community; while providing more opportunities for players deemed illegitimate for citizenship to experience the server's features.
- c. The Citizen Test will remain as-is, but will be renamed as the Immigration Clearance Examination (ICE), or simply "Immigration Test".
- d. There will also be changes to the Citizen rank in order to accommodate the proposed additional immigration regulations.

2. Permanent Resident (PR) rank details

- a. The new PR rank will retain many original citizenship privileges, including:
 - i. Employment in businesses and as railway drivers
 - ii. Permission to access Sandbox, Gardellia, and Pangaea
 - iii. Permission to build in Pangaea
 - iv. Permission to use stored-value Metro+ cards
 - v. Permission to speak in the WolvHaven Discord
 - vi. Permission to own property in the City
- b. However, the following privileges require further promotion to citizenship:
 - i. Ownership of public housing units
 - ii. Eligibility to vote in server elections
 - iii. Eligibility to form or join political parties
 - iv. Permission to apply for Architect rank
 - v. Receiving Donor rank privileges
 - vi. Permission to build in Sandbox and Laboratory

- vii. Permission to apply to build in Gardellia
- viii. Citizen-tier punishment protocols for rule violations
- c. PRs are also subject to:
 - i. Taxation based on net worth
 - ii. Harsher tourist punishment protocols

3. Permanent Resident (PR) to Citizen Promotion Criteria

- a. Any permanent resident shall be granted citizenship by administrators under the following conditions:
 - i. Permanent Residency for at least 1 week, subject to behavioural monitoring reports from peers.
 - ii. The PR must submit to server staff a self-introduction document written in either essay or point form, stating their identity details, their rationale for joining the server, and what they could contribute to the server. The document must be in a language readable by at least one staff member.
 - iii. The PR must go through another (less intensive) round of manual background checks.
 - iv. The PR must have NO bans or active warnings in the past 3 months.
 - v. The monthly citizenship quota has not been exceeded. (ref clause 4a)
- b. A permanent resident shall be blacklisted (permanently refused) from obtaining citizenship if any of the following are met:
 - i. The PR has been (permanently) banned more than once.
 - ii. The PR is an active member of a rival server or cybercrime organisation blacklisted for acts of terrorism against WolvHaven.
- c. Administrators reserve the right to promote PRs to Citizen unconditionally if the PR in question has shown exceptionally benevolent behaviour.
- d. Administrators are also permitted to demote PRs to Tourist if the PR's current behaviour justifies such punishment.

4. Changes to the Citizen rank

- a. There will now be a maximum quota of citizen promotions to reduce the workload of Administrators and maintain the sustainability of the server community. The quota is to be reset every month, and the limit is dynamically determined based on the active player population, current availability of administrators, and the security level/defence readiness of the server.
- b. Citizens that satisfy any of the following conditions will be demoted to PR:
 - i. One unappealable permanent ban
 - ii. Two appealable permanent bans
 - iii. Four temporary bans due to warnings
 - iv. Eight imprisonment periods

- v. Convicted of acts of treason (e.g. espionage on behalf of foreign entities)

5. Short title

- a. This act may be cited as the Permanent Residency Act, 2017/2018.

6. Implementation

- a. This act will only go into effect once the following are met:
 - i. Approval from the President,
 - ii. Approval from the incumbent Prime Minister, and
 - iii. Server permissions updated according to the act details.
- b. Clause 4 is only to be enacted once Clauses 1, 2, 3 have been in effect for at least one month and deemed acceptable.
- c. Players promoted to Citizen before this act goes into effect will only be affected by clause 4b.
- d. Tourists who have completed the Citizen Test but have not yet been promoted before this act goes into effect will be promoted to Citizen if eligible.
- e. Tourists who take the Immigration Test after this act goes into effect will be subject to all relevant clauses of this act.
- f. In the event that this act is to be repealed without any equivalent replacement, all current PRs are to be immediately demoted to the Tourist rank.

Debate:

1. [hinwapoon, MP, NCP] Firstly, I would like to apologize to the house for my absence from the last session. If any MP has questions about the bill, please ask them in this session.
2. [autobus22, MP, HGP] I think I've laid out my concerns around people without staff experience getting this rank, wiki rank, and on the other side, the fact staff should already just be doing its job here in general, the amount of actions on wiki even with the increase would only account for about 5 minutes of work for the entire team together every week at absolute peak time. The crossbench will vote against this bill's acceptance if these concerns aren't properly addressed.
3. [MC_Dunc, MP, DEM] One believes that governing the wiki would not need that much of a staff experience, given that you and I don't have staff experience in this server. If we add wiki staffs to this server, we honestly can reduce the workload of staff, given the fact they have a huge workload already. If you haven't noticed due to your inactivity in the server, there are spam posts on the wiki that required staff to delete. It simply enables the better moderating of wiki and reduce the staff workload.
4. [minebuilder1223, PM, MP, PFG] Thank you Mr. Speaker. My government does not believe that this bill is necessary in response to the spam posts in the wiki and that the process for choosing wiki staff is too complicated for the roles these members play. I would be happy to accept another more fitting way of dealing with the spam posts problem, but both the way of choosing the staff and the small threat-which does not need much effort to dealt with- of spam posts not being so large. This government does not think this bill is currently necessary.

5. [hinwapoon, MP, NCP] Thank you Mr. Speaker. In response to the honourable member autobus22, in this bill, clause 3c and 3d, all newly appointed staff will be given a probationary period of 3 months. If they have done an exceptional job during the probationary period, they will become a competent wiki staff. I move to amend the bill where if the person has done a bad job during the probationary period, his probationary period will be extended by the senate, or revoked by the senate.

6. Amendment: Extension of or revoking of probationary period by senate

7. [ROM5149, MP, NAT] May the speaker focus on the bill at hand?

8. [SilverWolv, Independent] Thank you Mr. Speaker. I think the situation at hand is getting rather ludicrous. Anyways, I believe if citizens are truly worried about the spam on wiki, they can help them by blanking out the spam page and asking staff to delete it later on.

9. [hinwapoon, MP, NCP] I would ask the honourable member SilverWolv, what would happen if citizens blanken the page, but didn't tell the staff to delete it. If we implement wiki staff, server staff's work can can be decreased, and complete work on the server.

10. [SilverWolv, Independent] Currently, only admins have access to delete pages. It can be extended to moderators and maybe even helpers if really necessary. I move that the bill be mended to extend the perms to mods cause I don't believe that we should risk power abuse by hiring potential wiki staff without staff experience.

1. Purpose

- a. The Wiki Staff members are for moderating the wiki and oversees the members editing correctly and controlling spam.

2. Responsibility and Duties

- a. As a Wiki staff, they will help moderating the wiki, as there are no staffs in the wiki and there should be people moderating the wiki. These jobs will include watching for defamation and controlling and deleting spam accounts. Need it be and if it be possible, these responsibilities will extend to the website also.

3. Acceptance Criteria

- a. Any member who is ranked Moderator or above¹

4. Short Name

- a. This bill can be referred to as Wiki Staff Member Act, 2017.

5. Implementation

- a. This act will go into effect immediately after it receives approval from the president.

Replace freedom of claiming minecarts by citizens to address exploit of Ucars to enter restricted area of train driving centre.

Be enacted by the president of the federation of WolvHaven, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and Representatives, in this parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as follows -

1. Application for UCar License

- a. Existing sign placed at the wall of the WolvHaven city portal will be removed.
 - i. [Tourist] and [Permanent Resident] ranks are not entitled to apply for Ucar license. They are only allowed to use public transport.
 - ii. [Citizen] ranks and above are eligible to apply for Ucar license.

2. New Ucar Training Centre

- a. A new Ucar training centre will be set up, preferably the same building as Wolvhaven Train Driving Centre.
- b. Training will involve educating “students” the rules of driving Ucars, as implemented in real life and adapted to suit WolvHaven’s roads system.
 - i. Sample rules: Obey to traffic lights, let pedestrians crossed first*
 - ii. After training, “students” shall proceed to examination.
 - iii. First batch of examiners are elected by staff. All are probational until approved after 3 months by staff.

3. Ucar License Endorsement

- a. Endorsement policy
 - i. Endorsement must be given by Chief Examiner AND examiner who examined the candidate.
 - ii. Additional endorsements may be given, but maximum is 5.
 - iii. Endorsement is given in the form of a signed book.
 - iv. “Student” endorsed proceeds to claim Ucars from examiners.

4. Ucar ownership

- a. Ucar responsibility
 - i. Ucars should always be kept within the owner’s reach (i.e. inventory).
 1. After driving with Ucar, owner should keep in inventory immediately.
 2. Any unattended Ucars will be removed without notice.

3. Lost Ucars - owners can request for new one from examiner.
- b. Ucar ownership
 - i. Each player who was endorsed is entitled to one Ucar only.
 - ii. Players are NOT allowed to exchange, share, lend Ucars among themselves.
 - iii. If caught having more than 1 Ucar, all of the extra Ucars shall be confiscated.
 - iv. Further investigation shall be conducted. Punishment is given accordingly. Warnings shall not exceed 1 official warning unless authorised by staff of rank [Admin] and above.

5. Implementation

- a. Examiners
 - i. First batch of examiners shall be chosen before implementing examinership.
 - ii. All Ucars are to be cleared from ALL inventories after examiners are elected.
 - iii. Existing citizens have to apply for Ucar License.

Inf act, if they do come back after their warning period expires to commit the same offense again, it is part of current staff protocol to just slap them with another official warning of the same reason and I guess which leads them quicker to the ban they they deserve. 1 loooooooooong and redundant warning or 2 warnings.
5. [y0urs_Tr1y, MP, Independent] I would like to point out to my dearest autobus, that last week we introduced an amendment to the warning system where players who obtain 6 warnings within 6 months are awarded a permanent ban.

Be it enacted by the president of the federation of WolvHaven, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and Representatives, in this parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as follows -

1. Proposed changes:

- a. Allow the council to extend warnings by up to two months if the council thinks a player did not learn or wasn't punished long enough for his or her offense.

2. Reason(s):

- a. Two months could be rather short in some cases. Additionally some people who are warning with one or multiple warnings just leave till they are cleared again to avoid being banned for multiple warnings, negating the purpose warnings have and how the punishment system works.

Secondly , for the cabinet members, should they be referred to as secretaries or ministers. Thirdly, his MP has already created a prime minister rank on discord just for the PM which supposedly already contains the permissions stated in the bill. If the rank still has deficiencies, would the PM accept a

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temporary administrator rank to sort the rank out, or would the PM request us admins to do the changes instead

5. [minebuilder1223, PM, MP, PFG] In regards to the first point, There is a clause included which states that the senate or president can veto the decision, but i would be happy to also include a clause to give the power to the senate and/or president to impeach also from your advice. As for the second point, I believe that minister may slightly be closer to religious connections. Therefore, I chose secretary as it is more neutral and lastly, I was already aware of the Prime Minister Rank, but it is not something laid down in law, and could simply be taken as something informal which won't extend to other premierships, Therefore i believe that it was necessary to put down on paper the rank and it's permissions in the discord server.
6. [autobus22, MP, HGP] A motion of impeachment should also be available for parliament itself for the simple fact the senate under this system may be strongly influenced by the party of people as proposed by the prime minister (or past prime minister. Secondly the crossbench does not feel like these secretaries need to be laid out in such a fashion, there is simply no reason to do so as multiple members may or may not have such knowledge, and everyone can inject their stance and questions into parliament either way. The crossbench has no comment on the third point.
7. Government and Parliament Reform Bill

Reform and revise the powers and responsibilities of an incumbent government

Be it enacted by the president of the federation of WolvHaven, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and Representatives, in this parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as follows -

I. Powers to be introduced

- A. The prime minister has the power to nominate elected members of his/her government to become members of the senate.
 - 1. Both the Senate and the President must approve the decision before the member can be appointed
- B. Upon advice from the Prime Minister, the President must declare a state of emergency.
 - 1. This state of emergency lasts for 7 days, unless parliament votes to extend it.
 - 2. In this time, emergency laws can be put in place without approval by the House of Representatives, Senate or President.
 - a) These laws must be voted on by parliament as soon as the state of emergency expires
 - 3. The state of emergency can be vetoed by the president or the senate at any time.
 - 4. The president no longer must ask the Senate for approval to declare a state of emergency.

II. Cabinet

- A. The prime minister must assign a cabinet consisting of a Leader of the House, Secretary of State for Infrastructure, Home Secretary, Secretary of State for Gardellia and Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs and upon gaining office after a general election.
 - 1. These secretaries are made up of the elected members of the incumbent government.
 - a) In the event that there are not enough members to fill every role, Roles will be filled with the first in the list taking priority.
 - 2. The role of these secretaries is to represent their respective sectors in the parliament and advise the Prime Minister.

III. Obligations

- A. The prime minister must be assigned a discord role on the WolvHaven discord server by the name of “Prime Minister” upon achieving or retaining office after a general election
 - 1. This role will (in addition to permissions granted to verified members)-
 - a) Be displayed separately from online members
 - b) Have the power to mention “@everyone”
 - c) Have access to #announcements channel

IV. Extent

- A. This act extends to WolvHaven City, Gardellia, Pangea, Sandbox and Laboratory.

V. Commencement

- A. All sections will come into force following the next general election after this act is passed

VI. Short Title

- A. This act may be cited as the Government and Parliament Reform Act 2018
